At home:

1. Find different pictures, including those of artworks that depict people having a meal. If possible, include pictures of people eating meals accompanied by their pets.
2. The following are examples of famous paintings depicting meals:

- ✓ *The Blind Man's Meal* by Pablo Picasso
- ✓ *Luncheon of the Boating Party* by Pierre Auguste Renoir
- ✓ *The Last Supper* by Leonardo da Vinci
- ✓ *The Harvester's Meal* by Pieter Brueghel, the Younger

3. Make a couple of rough sketches for an artwork in which you draw people having a meal.
4. In this picture you also have to include more than one animal next to or near the people.
